Manipur minister submits resignation, to take final decision on Tuesday

Imphal, April 15 : Senior Manipur Minister L. Jayentakumar tendered his resignation in protest against uncalled for interference by Chief Minister N. Biren Singh rocking the month-old BJP-led coalition government. He said later that he has spoken to the Chief Minister and would take a final decision on Tuesday.

Jayentakumar who held the Health portfolio and three other departments told reporters that he would announce his decision on whether to remain a minister after Chief Minister Biren Singh returns from Delhi on Tuesday.

It will be premature to take a decision in his absence he said.

Jayentakumar had submitted his resignation letter on Friday evening in protest against uncalled for interference by Biren. The Chief Minister later rushed to Delhi to fire-fit the political threat it was learnt.

Jayentakumar admitted that the Chief Minister had called him up to enquire for reasons behind his resignation. It is understood that he had ventilated his grievances like interference in his official work.

Biren in his capacity as the Minister in charge of the Department of Personnel had suspended Okram Ibomcha the Health Director without consulting Jayentakumar.

There was no specific charge against Ibomcha. The suspension order said that it was to take disciplinary actions against Ibomcha a close relative of previous Congress Chief Minister Okram Ibobi Singh.

Jayentakumar is one of the four MLAs of the National People's Party (NPP) who was sworn in on March 15 when the Bharatiya Janata Party-led coalition government was formed. Answering queries from reporters on the suspension of Health Director Ibomcha the Minister said the Chief Minister had informed me about this step. Asked if the suspension was justified he told the reporters You should ask the high officials concerned.

Another grievance that Jayentakumar had was that despite his recommendation Dr Rajo the family welfare director was not made the interim Health Director. Besides he was not consulted when Biren Singh appointed an Advocate General. Jayentakumar is also the Law Minister.

Indications are that Jayentakumar will agree to withdraw his resignation if the Chief Minister backs out from these two appointments. The Chief Minister has not made any comment on the issue so far.

In his resignation letter the Minister says he is thankful to the Chief Minister for inducting him in the ministry. But he was not able to fulfil his vision due to the interference.

Y. Joykumar NPP MLA from Uripok who is a former Director General of Police is also believed to be unhappy. Joykumar who is the Deputy Chief Minister had reportedly wanted the Home portfolio which is important in insurgency-hit Manipur. However Biren kept it with him.

The coalition ministry was sworn in on March 15. Nine MLAs of BJP NPP Naga People's Front LJP and Congress (I) Parliamentary secretaries were sworn in on March 23.

Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav, North East, the biggest cultural confluence of India

New Delhi, Apr 15: The fifth Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav was organized by the Union Ministry of Culture under the aegis of Government of India in North Eastern Region from 23 to 31 March, 2017. The nine days cultural extravaganza showcased the Cultural Heritage of India in different parts of North Eastern states viz. Dimapur in Nagaland, Majuli in Assam, Imphal in Manipur, Aizawl in Mizoram, Gangtok in Sikkim, Shillong in Meghalaya and Khowai in Tripura. The biggest cultural festival of India had confluence nearly 5000 artists from North East India and 2000 artists from across the country depicting almost 300 art forms of India. All most all the art forms of North East India have been showcased in Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav connecting more than 4 crores audience of the region. With the magnanimous effort of Union Ministry of Culture, Government of India supported by Government of Arunachal Pradesh, especially Hon'ble Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, Shri Pema Khandu, the festival was inaugurated at a place like Tawang. Despite natural oddities at Tawang, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, Shri Pema Khandu, Hon'ble Minister Art and Culture, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Dr. Mohesh Chai, Hon'ble Member of Legislative Assembly, Shri Tsering Tashi graced the inaugural ceremony of the festival on 23 March at Parade Ground in presence of Director of EZCC (Kolkata) and Director (I/C) of NEZCC (Dimapur), Dr. Om Prakash Bharti amidst almost 5000 audience. The closing ceremony of the first series of Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav at Tawang on 25 March was graced by Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Government of India, Shri Kiren Rijiju.

The enthralled audience of Tawang thronged in thousands shutting down their household chores and professional ventures to witness the cultural programmes held on the occasion of the Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav - North East. Dance, music, theatre, puppetry have been the components of culture since the dawn of Indian civilization.

To preserve, promote and popularize the heritage and cultural diversity of Indian culture and reconnect the new generation with Indian culture, the Union Ministry of Culture had conceptualized Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav in 2015. Thereafter the festival has been organized at IGNC A of New Delhi (1 to 8 November, 2015 and 15 to 23 October, 2016), Varanasi (17 to 24 December, 2016) and Bengaluru (5 to 8 March, 2017). The fifth Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav held in North Eastern Region of India exhibited folk and classical art forms in all its dimensions - dance, music, theatre and puppetry. More than 250 dance and music traditions of India have been showcased in the festival. The exhibition on Buddhist arts portrayed the splendor of the cultural sphere nurtured on the lap of Himalayas.

The Himalayan masks and Thangka paintings echoed the heritage of the snow-capped region. Handicraft mela and food fair organized on the occasion of Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav also exhibited the varied components of Indian Cultural Heritage.

Rich and unique folk theatrical art forms of India including Nautanki of Uttar Pradesh, Mughal Tamasha of Odisha, Bhand Patthar of Jammu and Kashmir, Sang of Haryana, Machh of Madhya Pradesh, Natua Nach of Bihar, Kharsawa Chhau of Jharkhand, Bidesiya of Bihar and Ojhapali, Nangli Geet, Bhari Gaan, Bhawaiya and Kushan Gaan of Assam have been showcased through Lok Rang Mahotsav held on the occasion of Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav in Sipahjar.

Dudhnoi and Gouripur of Assam from 27 to 30 March. The age old puppetry traditions of India like Ravan Chawa of Odisha, Kathputli of Rajasthan, Kalasutri Bahulya of Maharashtra, Laithibi Jagoi of Manipur, Glove and Rod puppet of Uttar Pradesh, Manob Putul of West Bengal and contemporary puppets have been presented in 100 schools of Guwahati

through Putul Tamasha reaching almost 70,000 school students. Through the sanskritik yatra, artistes met and interacted with several tribes and communities of almost 100 villages inhabiting in the North Eastern states of India thereby proliferating cultural exchange.

As the festival was being implemented through the seven Zonal Cultural Centres and other cultural organizations under Ministry of Culture, it truly promote the cultural inter-linkages amongst the states thereby strengthening National integration and also bind the artists of other parts of the country with the people of North East in a single thread of culture. The North East Zonal Cultural Centre (NEZCC), Dimapur had been entrusted as the nodal agency to carry forward the execution of the national cultural festival. Each Zonal Cultural Centre had been provided with slots by the Union Ministry of Culture to present their art forms during the festival. Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav has thereby become an amalgamation of 'Ek Bharat, Srestha Bharat'. The festival had been convened at Holy
