CBI raids 9 locations in West

Kolkata, Oct 10: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) carried out searches in Kolkata, West Bengal's North 24 Parganas and Bihar on Tuesday in connection with alleged illegal imports in the country in collusion with customs officials. CBI sources said the raids took place after an FIR was registered against deputy commissioner Navneet Kumar, appraiser Vicky Kumar and a person named Mohammed Naseruddin. The deputy commissioner and the appraiser have already been suspended by the customs department. The central probe agency had stumbled across incidents of illegal imports by custom officials by evasion of duty, thus causing losses to the public exchequer.

113 candidates file nomination on final day in West District



Gyalshing, Oct 10: The 7th and final day for nomination filing of the candidates in the West District for the upcoming Panchayat Elections saw a total of 113 nominations.

22 nominations were filed for Zilla Territorial Constituencies to the Returning Officer which included 3 BJP, 4 SDF, 1 SKM and 14 Independent candidates.

As informed by Kapil Meena, R.O (West), the scrutiny of nominations will be carried out from 11am onwards tomorrow.

Scrutiny will take place as per the Election rules. The respective AROs and their team will assist the RO in the process, which is a quasi-judicial process.

Moreover, 92 candidates filed nominations to the Asst. Returning Officers under the ward level out of which 1 was BJP, 16 were SDF, 20 were SKM and 55 were Independent candidates.

On the closing of the nomination filing from October 3 to 10, a total of 85 candidates filed nominations for the 31 Zilla Territorial Constituencies with 3 from BJP, 35 from SDF, 11 from SKM and 36 Independent candidates.

For the 348 wards under 61 GPU, a total of 653 nominations were filed with 1 from BJP, 380 from

Woman files police complaint against ousted CPI-M MP

Kolkata, Oct 10: A woman who accused expelled CPI (M) parliamentarian Ritabrata Banerjee of cohabiting with her on the pretext of marriage on Tuesday lodged a police complaint against him and he in turn hit back by filing a complaint against her.

"I have come to lodge a complaint against him and will meet the Superintendent of Police," the woman said. In a social media post, she had earlier claimed the local police had refused to record her complaint.

influential political persons to cause harm to my life, property, career and malign my reputation in society."

He also uploaded on Twitter a few screenshots of a WhatsApp conversation he purportedly had with the woman, during which "she asked for Rs 50 lakh for not filing an FIR".

"Hard Facts. Manufactured Lies" will be combated. Will not succumb to "politically aided" threats," he said in his Twitter handle.

"He promised to marry me and gave me tickets to come to his 104 South Avenue flat (in Delhi). We had physical relationship... he is now completely denying it (promise to marry her). He gave me Rs 2.5 lakh a couple of days back as compensation for having physical relations with him," the woman said.

Banerjee claimed the woman had made the accusations against him to "malign my reputation as I did not yield to her demand for Rs 50 lakh".

In his complaint at the Garfa police station in Kolkata, he said: "... she threatened to cause harm to my life and career. I strongly apprehend such malicious acts of her are politically motivated and backed by

According to Banerjee, the woman "portrayed and represented herself" to be a hapless woman in urgent need of a loan to pursue education abroad.

Banerjee claimed he helped her secure a loan from a Balurghat branch of the State Bank of India but she continued to make repeated monetary demands.

"I was ... lured to meet her material demands till I realised her demands were boundless... she informed me she was suffering from lymphoma and again demanded money for her treatment. Due to her threat, I was compelled to make a payment of Rs 2.25 lakhs on July 20," the Raja Sabha MP said in his complaint.

The woman, however, said his claims were false.

WB TET 2018: Official notification Declared at wbbpe.org

Kolkata, Oct 10: The West Bengal Teacher Eligibility Test (WB TET) official notification has been announced at wbbpe.org. Official sources mention that the West Bengal TET exam will be organized by the West Bengal Board of Primary Education to fill thirty thousand posts in the state. Candidates need to keep in mind that in order to appear for WB TET 2018, they must complete a two-year teacher training programme or secure at least 50 per cent in their Higher Secondary Examinations. Education Minister of Kolkata Partha Chatterjee underlined the changes in the eligibility criteria for WB TET 2018, adding that candidates who have met the eligibility criteria can apply for the exam online. He urged the Primary Education Board to issue a notification after the Board office opens on October 9 stipulating the two conditions as per the guidelines mentioned by the Department of School Education, Government of West Bengal. The WB government in April had issued a notification stating that the Teachers Eligibility Test (TET) for primary school teachers will be organized in line with the National Council for Teachers' Education guidelines.
